Lake Preston School Winter Athletics & Activities Home Event Guidelines

Circumstances related to the Covid-19 pandemic are constantly changing and the circumstances vary from community to community. Individuals that are at-risk or are ill should not attend school events. The health and safety of students, staff, and community remain the priority of the Lake Preston School District as we provide an opportunity to participate in the winter activities.

Winter Athletics

- Boys Basketball – Tier 1 (Open Attendance)
 - Admission with Ticket Takers - \$5.00 for adult, \$3.00 for student
 - May use voucher system: 2-6 vouchers per family pending Tier or space in facility (ex. DH)
 - K-5 students & under age 5 must sit with parent(s) during the entire game/night
 - Masks recommended, not required
 - Concessions – limited
 - Designated seating arrangements
- Girls Basketball – Tier 1 (Open Attendance) – JV/MS Schedule
 - No admission, no ticket takers
 - K-5 students & under age 5 must sit with parent(s) during the entire game/night
 - Concessions – limited
 - Masks recommended, not required
 - Designated seating arrangements
- Wrestling
 - Follow DeSmet & Arlington Protocols

Tier	Fan Attendance	Mask Protocol	Conditions
Tier 1	Open Attendance	Highly Recommended	Steady/Decreasing rates of community active cases, new cases, and hospitalizations.
Tier 2	4-6 Voucher System	Highly Recommended	Slow/intermittent increase of community active cases, new cases, and hospitalizations. Isolated cases, no evidence of exposures in large communal settings.
Tier 3	Parents Only or 2-4 Voucher System	Required	Steady/incremental increase of community active cases, new cases, and hospitalizations. Sustained increases, potential exposures in large communal settings.
Tier 4	No Fans	Required	Sharp increase of community active cases, new cases, and/or hospitalizations WITHOUT concurrent increase of cases/contacts within the school setting. Confirmed exposures in large communal settings.

Please note that other schools may have different guidelines in place and all guidelines are subject to change throughout the winter season.
